

Measuring for your countertops

First, don't worry; measurements to within an inch are OK and neatness will not be graded. This is used just to give you an estimate of what your countertops will cost. If you decide to go forward with your countertop project a professional will visit your home and take accurate measurements and review all aspects of the job with you prior to fabricating your countertops!

1. Draw a simple plan of your countertops.
2. Write down the measurements along the back (wall) of you cabinets or existing countertops.
3. Note the depth of your countertops, if they vary from one side to another note the different dimensions.
4. Note the location of sink, cook top or range, etc.
5. Note any thing else that you think might affect your countertops.
